HMRC: New Construction Industry Scheme (CIS) Tax Changes for Contractors & Subcontractors

Effective 6th April 2007, HMRC is changing the way in which subcontractors within the construction industry are registered, how they are paid and how the pay as you earn (PAYE) tax is deducted.

Under the new Scheme, contractors will become more liable in defining the employment status of each subcontractor in addition to submitting monthly returns to the taxman.

Failure to comply with the new regulations may include fines such as certificate cancellations for the contractor, penalty proceedings, and legal prosecution.
